I.

All previous responses to discovery and Bills of Particulars are incorporated herein.

II.

The battery/malfeasance referenced in Count 13 is detailed on pages 52 and 53 of the expert report from Seth Stoughton, those pages attached hereto as Exhibit A. They clearly reference a time frame via time stamp, and clearly indicate the owner/operator video from which they were derived. The time stamps referenced on those pages are not exclusive, and represent a singular frame of the referenced battery, all of which has been in possession of the defendant since March 14, 2023. Stoughton's report may be found at "LSP/LSP Thumb Drive 2/Preliminary Expert Report, 11-29-2022."

WHEREFORE, the State of Louisiana, through the undersigned Assistant District Attorney, prays that these particulars be deemed good and sufficient.







When standing near where Mst. Tpr. York was bending over Mr. Greene, Dep. Harpin raised his knee for a prolonged period in a position consistent with placing his foot onto Mr. Greene (although the video is not definitive on this point), as reflected in the following screen captures:









Around this time, Mr. Greene continued to make wordless noises consistent with expressions of pain or distress while also verbalizing, "I'm sorry," and, "Okay, okay, okay, okay." 148

Mst. Tpr. Hollingsworth walked back over to where Dep. Harpin and Mst. Tpr. York were interacting with Mr. Greene, and all three officers appeared to bend over Mr. Greene. 149

Shortly thereafter, Mr. Greene made a loud noise consistent with an expression of pain or distress and one of the nearby officers said, "Yeah! Yeah, that shit hurts, doesn't it?" Within a few seconds, Mr. Greene loudly says, "Okay. Alright, Lord Jesus. Oh, Lord. Okay, okay. Lord Jesus" and apologizing several times. 151

While Mr. Greene was speaking, officers rolled him to his side¹⁵² and told him to sit on his butt.¹⁵³ At this point, Mr. Greene had been kept in the prone position for approximately ten minutes and nineteen seconds (0:10:19) after being secured in handcuffs¹⁵⁴ and approximately one minute and
