## **BILL OF PARTICULARS** IN COMPLIANCE WITH ORDER DATED JULY 10, 2023

NOW INTO COURT, through the undersigned Assistant District Attorney, comes the State of Louisiana, and in compliance with the court's order respectfully provides the following particulars in relation to Counts 3-10 of the indictment issued against Kory York:

I.

All previous responses to discovery and Bills of Particulars are incorporated herein.

II.

The battery/malfeasance referenced in Count 3 is detailed on page 41 of the expert report from Seth Stoughton, attached hereto as Exhibit A. Clearly referenced is a time frame via time stamp, and clearly displayed is the owner/operator video from which it was derived. The time stamps referenced are not exclusive, and represent a singular frame of the referenced battery, all of which has been in possession of the defendant since March 14, 2023. Stoughton's report may be found at "LSP/LSP Thumb Drive 2/Preliminary Expert Report, 11-29-2022."

III.

The battery/malfeasance referenced in Count 4 is detailed on page 42 of the expert report from Seth Stoughton, attached hereto as Exhibit B. Clearly referenced is a time frame via time stamp, and clearly displayed is the owner/operator video from which it was derived. The time stamps referenced are not exclusive, and represent a singular frame of the referenced battery, all of which has been in possession of the defendant since March 14, 2023. Stoughton's report may be found at "LSP/LSP Thumb Drive 2/Preliminary Expert Report, 11-29-2022."

IV.

The battery/malfeasance referenced in Count 5 is detailed on page 43/44 of the expert report from Seth Stoughton, attached hereto as Exhibit C. Clearly referenced is a time frame via time stamp, and clearly displayed is the owner/operator video from which it was derived. The time stamps referenced are not exclusive, and represent a singular frame of the referenced battery, all of which has been in possession of the defendant since March 14, 2023. Stoughton's report may be found at "LSP/LSP Thumb Drive 2/Preliminary Expert Report, 11-29-2022."

V.

The battery/malfeasance referenced in Count 6 is detailed on page 46 of the expert report from Seth Stoughton, attached hereto as Exhibit D. The time stamps referenced are not exclusive, and represent a singular frame of the referenced battery, all of which has been in possession of the defendant since March 14, 2023. VI.

The battery/malfeasance referenced in Count 7 is detailed on page 48/49 of the expert report from Seth Stoughton, attached hereto as Exhibit E. Clearly referenced is a time frame via time stamp, and clearly displayed is the owner/operator video from which it was derived. The time stamps referenced are not exclusive, and represent a singular frame of the referenced battery, all of which has been in possession of the defendant since

March 14, 2023. Stoughton's report may be found at "LSP/LSP Thumb Drive 2/Preliminary Expert Report, 11-29-2022."

#### VII.

The battery/malfeasance referenced in Count 8 is detailed on page 50 of the expert report from Seth Stoughton, attached hereto as Exhibit F. Clearly referenced is a time frame via time stamp, and clearly displayed is the owner/operator video from which it was derived. The time stamps referenced are not exclusive, and represent a singular frame of the referenced battery, all of which has been in possession of the defendant since March 14, 2023. Stoughton's report may be found at "LSP/LSP Thumb Drive 2/Preliminary Expert Report, 11-29-2022."

#### VIII.

The battery/malfeasance referenced in Count 9 is detailed on page 57/58 of the expert report from Seth Stoughton, attached hereto as Exhibit G. Clearly referenced is a time frame via time stamp, and clearly displayed is the owner/operator video from which it was derived. The time stamps referenced are not exclusive, and represent a singular frame of the referenced battery, all of which has been in possession of the defendant since March 14, 2023. Stoughton's report may be found at "LSP/LSP Thumb Drive 2/Preliminary Expert Report, 11-29-2022."

### IX.

The battery/malfeasance referenced in Count 10 is detailed on page 59/60 of the expert report from Seth Stoughton, attached hereto as Exhibit H. Clearly referenced is a time frame via time stamp, and clearly displayed is the owner/operator video from which it was derived. The time stamps referenced are not exclusive, and represent a singular frame of the referenced battery, all of which has been in possession of the defendant since

March 14, 2023. Stoughton's report may be found at "LSP/LSP Thumb Drive 2/Preliminary Expert Report, 11-29-2022."



York was standing with his left foot on Mr. Greene's right shoulder area, as reflected in the following screen capture:




Shortly thereafter, Mst. Tpr. York stepped off of Mr. Greene and used the toe of his right boot to kick, apparently lightly, Mr. Greene in the right thigh, as reflected in the following screen capture:

At the time, Mr. Greene was still in the prone position, but his hips were canted slightly to the side. 121

Shortly after that, Mst. Tpr. York used his left foot to stomp down on Mr. Greene's right buttock area, apparently pushing that hip to the ground as reflected in the following screen captures:



Tpr. DeMoss's BWC and Lt. Clary's BWC, 129 which allows visual events captured on Tpr. DeMoss's BWC to be associated with auditory events recorded on Lt. Clary's BWC. 130

Mst. Tpr. York was standing over Mr. Greene apparently holding the back of his pants, as reflected in the following screen capture:



While Mr. Greene and Mst. Tpr. York were in that position, Mst. Tpr. Hollingsworth applied leg shackles to Mr. Greene.<sup>131</sup>

As Lt. Clary approached the location of the crash where troopers were standing with Mr. Greene, Mr. Greene said, "Aw, yes, sir." An unidentified officer said, "Quit moving," and Mr. Greene responded, "Okay, okay." Mr. Greene then made a higher pitch, wordless noise consistent with



Mr. Greene responded, "Yes, sir." 139

Shortly thereafter, Mst. Tpr. York reached down and grabbed the chain of the leg shackles, dragging Mr. Greene backwards for a short distance, <sup>140</sup> as reflected in the following screen captures:










As Mst. Tpr. York dragged him backward, Mr. Greene said, "Okay, okay, sir!" 141

Mst. Tpr. York moved to a position to Mr. Greene's left, knelt on his back, and yelled, "You're going to lay on your fucking belly like I told you to, you understand?" While in this position, Mst. Tpr. York maintained his grip on the chain between the leg shackles, pulling Mr. Greene's feet up as reflected in the following screen capture:



Mr. Greene again said, "Yes, sir," and made several wordless noises consistent with an expression of pain or distress.<sup>143</sup>

Mst. Tpr. York then said, "You act right, I'll let you go." 144

It is not clear how long Mst. Tpr. York held Mr. Greene in that position; approximately nine seconds later, Mst. Tpr. York released Mr. Greene, leaving him in the prone position and remaining in a position over him.<sup>145</sup>



Tpr. DeMoss knelt near Mr. Greene and recited a version of the *Miranda* warnings. When Tpr. DeMoss asked Mr. Greene why he ran, Mr. Greene twice started to answer but was either unwilling or unable to before he said, "I was just tired." 161

Although not entirely clear from the video, the sudden increase in Mr. Greene's apparent expressions of pain or discomfort, <sup>162</sup> the way Mr. Greene apparently held his eyes shut, and, to a lesser extent, the fact that Mr. Greene apparently had to try speaking several times before being able to respond to Tpr. DeMoss's questioning are consistent with exposure to OC spray. It is worth noting that in a later Use of Force Report, Mst. Tpr. Hollingsworth indicated that he used OC spray in "[o]ne 1/2 second burst to the facial area," <sup>163</sup> although there is no additional detail about when during the encounter that occurred.

Almost immediately after, Mr. Greene fell to his right, as reflected in the following screen capture:



As he fell to his side, Mr. Greene said, "Hey, sir" and made a series of wordless noises consistent

with expressions of pain or distress. 164

Within a few seconds, Mst. Tpr. York, who was still behind Mr. Greene, pushed Mr. Greene forward, causing Mr. Greene to shout, and said, "Quit fucking pushing against me, you understand that?" <sup>165</sup> Mr. Greene did not answer, but continued making a series of wordless noises consistent with expressions of pain or distress. <sup>166</sup>

At approximately this point, Lt. Clary moved away; although certain subsequent events were audio recorded, there is no known video recording.

Shortly thereafter, Mr. Greene made another loud noise consistent with an expression of pain or distress and said, "Oh, okay. Alright, okay. Alright." At the time, Lt. Clary's BWC suggests that Mst. Tpr. York was saying something to Mr. Greene, but his words were inaudible until he said, "I got your attention now? Do what I tell you to do." 168

Mr. Greene responded, "Yes, sir." 169

Mst. Tpr. York said, "Do what I tell you to do." 170

Mr. Greene again responded, "Yes, sir." 171

Mst. Tpr. York said, "Lay there and relax and [inaudible.]" 172

Mr. Greene continued making a series of wordless noises consistent with expressions of pain or distress. <sup>173</sup> A few seconds later, the volume of Mr. Greene's noises increased. <sup>174</sup>



When Lt. Clary walked back toward Mr. Greene, officers had again placed him into the prone position, as reflected in the following screen capture:



Lt. Clary approached Tpr. DeMoss for a short conversation, during which time Mr. Greene continued to make a series of wordless noises consistent with expressions of pain or distress. <sup>175</sup> The noises that Mr. Greene was making became more strained and quieter. <sup>176</sup>

Lt. Clary's BWC captured one of Mr. Greene's feet moving up twice while he was being held prone. 177 Mr. Greene then stops making noise or moving.

For a period before and at the time, Mr. Greene was in the prone position with Mst. Tpr. Hollingsworth and Mst. Tpr. York holding him down, as reflected in the screen captures on the following page:


