On 05-30-2018 at 18:35 hrs I, SSgt. K. Brown, was called out to City Hall in Donaldsonville in reference to a (Carnal Knowledge) case involving a 16yr old W/F who is pregnant by her 48yr old boy-friend who is is now talking about having indecent conversations with one of our School Security Officers (Fred Corder) while he was working his 2 week rotation at Donaldsonville High.

Upon my arrival, I spoke with who gave me a taped statement of her involvement with her older boy-friend who she was living with. Towards the end of the statement started telling me how she met one of our Police officers at her School. She said that Fred Corder, approached her at Donaldsonville High and started talking to her about her ROTC uniform. She said this would have been a Wednesday possibly the 21<sup>st</sup> or the 28<sup>th</sup> of February because that's the only days she would wear her ROTC uniform. said that Fred spoke about his connections with the National Guard in Gonzales and told her he could give her information if she was interested. She said he told her that someone told him that she liked older men and maybe they could be friends. She said YES but just friends. This is when she told me that Fred started talking about his wife or ex wife she couldn't remember. said Fred told her his wife doesn't have sex right and maybe she could "suck his dick" said she told him no but they exchanged phone numbers that day.


said she and Fred texted back and forth that night and he talked about her sucking his dick again. She said that Fred asked her to send him pictures of all her tattoos because he noticed the ones on her ankles at school. Said that Fred sent her a picture of a tattoo on his ankle but she couldn't make it out. Said she sent him pictures of her tattoos on her thigh, lower back and the one on her front hip. Said she also send a picture of her breast she took in a mirror. When she asked for a picture of his "dick" He told her he couldn't send that because he could get in trouble. The next day told me that Fred texted her about picking her up and she lied to him and said she had a track meet at school. Fred said he could pick her up and bring her home. Later that afternoon was fishing with her Boy-friend on the levy and dropped her phone in the water. She said that next School Security Officer at Donaldsonville after Fred walked up to her and gave her a piece of paper with Fred's phone number and she was told to call Fred in reference to some information regarding the National Guard. Said she took the paper but never called or text Fred again.

On 7-12-18, Major Craig Beaman along with Lt. Mike Songy, Lt. Gerald Whealton, SSgt. Mike Brunner, SSgt. Kelly Brown, and SSgt. Bob Escamillia reviewed Case # 18-24056 involving allegations made by a sixteen year old female against former Ascension Parish Sheriff's Deputy

The purpose of the review was to establish if any crimes had been committed in accordance with Louisiana law. After reviewing the case collectively, it was a consensus that there was no evidence to support a criminal charge against

On 7-12-18 at approximately 10:30 am, the same group of investigators met with First Assistant District Attorney Larry Buquoi of the 23<sup>rd</sup> Judicial District Attorney's Office. After reviewing the case, Mr. Buquoi advised investigators that we did not have any evidence which would allow him to prosecute a criminal charge against

On 10-30-18, I contacted investigator Ike VaVasseur with the Louisiana Department Of Justice, Office Of The Attorney General, in reference to a complaint his office received about a case involving former Ascension Parish Sheriff's deputy Fred Corder. The complainant alleged the Sheriff's Office did not complete an investigation, covered up the investigation so Fred Corder would not be arrested, and allowed him to resign. Investigator VaVasseur advised me his investigation revealed the complaint was not true and unfounded. Investigator VaVasseur said he told the complainant he investigated his allegations and they were unfounded.
