In re: Request for Investigation of Malfeasance in Office

Dear Mr. Babin:

I have become aware of events which took place in the Ascension Parish Sheriff's Office which may rise to the level of criminal activity.

La. R.S. 14:134(A)(1) states "[m]alfeasance in office is committed when any public officer or public employee shall: (1) Intentionally refuse or fail to perform any duty lawfully required of him, as such officer or employee."

La. R.S. 13:5539 requires "[e]ach sheriff shall be keeper of the public jail of his parish and shall preserve the peace and apprehend public offenders.

The first instance of malfeasance of which I am aware and desire to be investigated involves the Sheriff's refusal to issue a warrant in an Ascension burglary involving a 17 year old, [REDACTED], who is the son of an Assumption Parish Sheriff Deputy and an employee of the Office of the District Attorney, contrary to the fact that the suspect has been identified by at least 2 of the suspects currently in custody and video evidence of the suspect's involvement as a principal to the burglary.


Based upon the fact that the target of this investigation is Jeff Wiley, Ascension Parish Sheriff, and others within the administration of the Ascension Parish Sheriff's Office, the investigation involves the child of an employee of the District Attorney's Office and the fact that the District Attorney, personally and publicly supported the Sheriff's daughter in her recent election for Ascension Parish Court Judge, I am requesting that the District Attorney recuse himself and his office from any further involvement in this matter and that the matter be transferred to the necessary State Agency for further investigation.

Upon transfer to the appropriate State Agency, I will provide all further instances of malfeasance of which I have obtained information. Please note that I have performed my duty under the law to notify law enforcement of possible crimes of which I am aware by notifying the Office of the Attorney General, The Louisiana State Police, the Inspector General, and the FBI.

Please have the appropriate State Agency contact me directly regarding any further investigation. Please do not continue to schedule appointments through Jeff Wiley for my appearance as he is the

target of this investigation and the information regarding the investigation should confidential.

Dear Ms. Landry:

This firm has been retained by Sheriff Wiley in connection with your client's allegations of long-standing "malfeasance." It is our understanding that your client declines to provide any information to Sheriff Wiley and has declined to provide any information to the District Attorney's Office citing an alleged "conflict." I further understand that the District Attorney has, accordingly, referred the matter to the Louisiana Attorney General.

Regardless of the status of any inquiry instigated by your client, my client is required to investigate claims of criminal conduct, even if, as alleged, they are involving the Sheriff's Office. Of particular concern are the statements your client previously made in correspondence wherein he revealed, for the first time, that he had already filed complaints with various law enforcement agencies. Yet, at no time has your client advised the Sheriff of any alleged violations of the law or any workplace act or practice in violation of the law. Rather, it appears your client has chosen, instead, to refuse to provide any information regarding his allegations to the Sheriff.

As a law enforcement officer, your client is obligated to report alleged crimes and, assuredly, as a Deputy with the Sheriff's Office, to fulfill his oath and obligation to the public and his office. Hence, the purpose of this letter is to request details regarding your client's allegations of alleged long-standing criminal violations. Please advise as to your availability and that of your client for receipt of the information in a meeting.

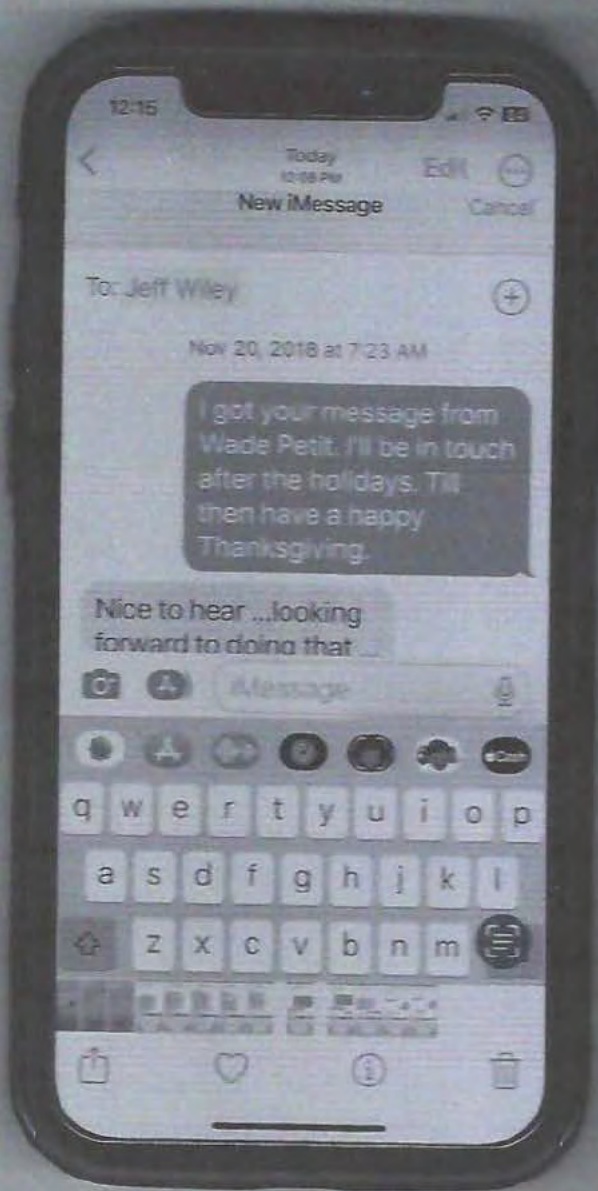
