Charges refuses. LBI SA Tommy Stubbs and I drove out to the victim's residence located at [REDACTED]. We knocked on the door and spoke with her mother in law who indicated she provided the contact letter to the victim. We were able to obtain a current cell number from the victim. Stubbs called and texted the number identifying himself and the reason we were trying to locate her. (Number is [REDACTED]). She texted back "I don't want nothing to do with it (the case) anymore." As previously noted in prior entries and reports, we cannot proceed without victim cooperation given the lack of corroborating evidence and time stamp issues on the alleged breast photo. State forced to refuse charges unless additional evidence surfaces.
